### How to apply for an award

All entrants must send in photographic evidence of at least **five or more** of the following, to include at least one from each column **A, B and C** and you will be eligible for a plaque.

A: Homes	B: Planting	C: Management
Wildlife pond	Wild Flower Meadow	Composting area
Log/rock pile or mini beast home	Climbing plants/trellises suitable for nesting & feeding	Long grass area
Bird or bat box	Insect friendly planting (nectar rich)	Chemical free (incl slug pellet free)
Bird feeding station or bath	Nettle patch	Water butt / recycled water
Bog or permanently wet area	Bird friendly planting (berries)	Quiet no-go areas for nesting birds
